The Blacksburg Junior Women's Club (BJWC) is a nonprofit organization of women who share a common desire to serve the community while building and enjoying lasting friendships. GFWC programs and projects focus on the major issues of our time—supporting women's health, preserving natural resources, promoting literacy and equality, and encouraging volunteer service—and fall into the following areas of focus: arts, conservation, education, home life, international affairs, and public affairs. The Blacksburg Junior Women's Club seeks to identify the needs in our area and to strive to meet those needs, specifically those involving women and children.

Three college scholarships, one for \$500 and two for \$250, are available for a graduating high school senior who has demonstrated strong participation in local community service activities that fall into one or more GFWC areas of interest. It is our hope that this scholarship will be a way to encourage students of great promise to continue with their involvement in community service. The scholarship can be used towards college tuition, books, and fees. The funds will be sent directly to the recipient's college of choice. It is required that the recipient attends college the fall semester after receiving the award. If the

Small restaurants face unique challenges. Every year one third of all new restaurants go out of business. This outcome is not typically due to the quality of the cooking or due to the lack of hard work. It is an invisibility problem. They are lost among so many options. These small business owners pour their money and dreams into their creation. They spend long exhausting days, cooking and cleaning only to have their efforts lost. It is tragic. CustomCook Inc. is offering a \$2,000 scholarship. This scholarship is to be awarded to the student that designs and implements the most successful social media post promoting a single location restaurant, ghost kitchen or freelance chef. The goal is to make the invisible visible.

Students can choose to promote any, single location restaurant, ghost kitchen or freelance chef. \$2,000 Scholarship: Rising Scientist Award for High School Students-DEADLINE July 5th, 2023

The Rising Scientist Awards, presented in partnership with <u>Hunter College</u>, are given annually to outstanding high school students who show exceptional promise in research areas related to mental health. Awards are presented at our annual <u>On the Shoulders of Giants scientific symposium</u> on October 4, 2023. The Child Mind Institute invites high school educators to nominate candidates entering their senior year in the Fall of 2023 for this honor.

To be selected for the Rising Scientist Awards a student must demonstrate:

- Outstanding interest and achievement in psychology, neuroscience or biomedical engineering research
- Strong academic performance in science courses
- Participation in related extracurricular activities
- Scientific research studies or independent research in one of the three areas of focus

Each Rising Scientist will receive:

- A \$2,000 scholarship for college expenses
- An opportunity to share his or her research at the Child Mind Institute's annual <u>On the Shoulders</u> of <u>Giants Scientific Symposium</u>, attended by world-class scientists.
- Recognition at an awards ceremony following the symposium, which is attended by VIP guests, including the Child Mind Institute's <u>Sarah Gund Distinguished Scientist</u>. The 2023 Distinguished Scientist Awardee is Margaret McCarthy, PhD, Chair, Department of Pharmacology; Director for the Program in Neuroscience (PIN) at the University of Maryland School of Medicine.
- Invitations to attend a special educational event with representatives from the <u>Child Mind</u> <u>Institute's research programs</u> and to shadow a Child Mind Institute researcher for a day.
- Recognition in press releases distributed to national media outlets, on childmind.org and in social media promotion
